Discovery 1:1	<input type="checkbox"/> God knows everything, like how many stars there are (even their names) and how many hairs you have on your head. <input type="checkbox"/> God knows everything about us. <input type="checkbox"/> God wants us to know about Him too. That's why He gave us the Bible. So we can know exactly what He wants us to know.
Discovery 1:3	<input type="checkbox"/> The Bible is all true. <input type="checkbox"/> God gave His Word to the men who wrote down the message to us. <input type="checkbox"/> God inspired the men to write what He wanted them to write. <input type="checkbox"/> Inspiration means God-breathed.
Discovery 1:4	<input type="checkbox"/> The Bible has two testaments - the Old and the New. <input type="checkbox"/> The Old Testament has 39 books. <input type="checkbox"/> The New Testament has 27 books.

Discovery 2:1	<input type="checkbox"/> All people sin. Like YOU, your Awana leader, your parents, grandparents great-grandparents. Everyone sins. <input type="checkbox"/> All people are born sinners.
Discovery 2:2	<input type="checkbox"/> Jesus is God and Jesus is the Son of God. Jesus is the Savior. <input type="checkbox"/> God's Word tells us exactly what we need to know.
Discovery 2:3	<input type="checkbox"/> We live in a messed-up-with-sin world. <input type="checkbox"/> As long as there is sin, there will be bad news. <input type="checkbox"/> BIG IMPORTANT QUESTION – Everyone is a sinner. Since we sin (and are unrighteous), how can we live up to God's standard of righteousness (totally perfect goodness)? <input type="checkbox"/> BIG IMPORTANT ANSWER – God sent His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to earth to take the punishment for our sins. By trusting Christ as Savior, we become <i>the righteousness of God</i> .
Discovery 2:5	<input type="checkbox"/> The Bible is "God's Instruction Book". <input type="checkbox"/> An "instruction" tells you how to do something.
Discovery 2:6	<input type="checkbox"/> The first four New Testament books, the gospels, were named after the men who wrote them. <input type="checkbox"/> Paul's books are letters written to friends or churches. The name of the book tells you to whom it is written. <input type="checkbox"/> Revelation is from the word 'reveal' which means to 'show'. God showed (revealed to) John what would happen in the future.
Discovery 3:1	<input type="checkbox"/> God created the ENTIRE world out of nothing. <input type="checkbox"/> God didn't need anything. Because God is God.
Disc. 3:4	<input type="checkbox"/> The New Testament was written in Greek
Discovery 3:5	<input type="checkbox"/> Life doesn't work without rules. <input type="checkbox"/> For life to work the right way, there need to be rules. <input type="checkbox"/> God makes the rules. He never makes a bad rule. He is always right. He is just. <input type="checkbox"/> God does not make mistakes.
Discovery 3:6	<input type="checkbox"/> God cannot sin. <input type="checkbox"/> He is perfect.
Disc. 4:3	<input type="checkbox"/> God is all-powerful.
Discovery 4:7	<input type="checkbox"/> God is everywhere. <input type="checkbox"/> God is with you.
